RESEEDING TIPS to ensure successful sward establishment

- 1. Soil test to develop a lime and fertiliser programme
- 2. Spray off the old sward with glyphosate
- **3.** Cultivate to ensure a fine, firm seedbed is achieved
- **4.** Select the best grass seed mixture for your requirements
- 5. Apply N, P and K as per requirements
- **6.** Sow at the recommended seeding rate in good conditions
- **7.** Roll well to ensure good soil to seed contact
- 8. Post-emergence weed spray is essential
- **9.** Graze the new reseeds frequently and at light covers
